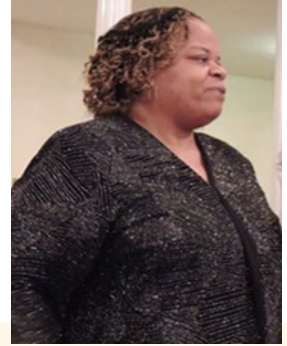


# Mother
